The Candidate who has passed the qualifying exam from other University / Statutory Board and Desiring to seek admission to any course of SGB Amravati University, is required to produce MIGRATION CERTIFICATE in the office, until 10th August or last date declared by the university, otherwise his admission will be cancelled. He is also required to get enrolled in SGB Amravati University after submitting the enrollment application in prescribed form along with necessary documents and prescribed fee (i.e. T.C., Marksheets, Gap Certificate)

- The student who has passed the qualifying exam private or externally should submit xerox copies of T.C., Marksheets, Gap Certificate, Affidavit regarding externally passing the exam along with enrollment form/Online Enrollment procedure.

- As per rules of Government of Maharashtra & SGB Amravati University, any of the specific course may not be started due to insufficient strength of the students.
